SHARING SUCCESSES & PROMISING PRACTICES *(1 hour)*

Through December, Coalition members will hear success stories from representatives in the priority areas defined in the Charter. Featured this month are two well-respected physicians from MUSC that will share best practices established in the Behavioral Health/Primary Care Outpatient Alignment priority area.

Dr. Constance Guille is a psychiatrist and Associate Professor in the Department of Psychiatry and Behavioral Sciences at MUSC. Her current primary clinical research focus is in opioid misuse and Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) in pregnancy. Collaboration through key-informant interviews with pregnant women and their providers, resulted in the development of a program for the reduction of opioid misuse and abuse in pregnancy. Based on an innovative plan ECHO (Extension for Community Healthcare Outcomes), the project is now integrated and delivered in-person and via telemedicine in obstetric practices in SC.

Dr. Kelly Barth is a psychiatrist and internal medicine doctor at MUSC who specializes in the management of chronic pain and opioid dependence. Dr. Barth will share MUSC's successful efforts to bridge the gap between the need for behavioral health treatment and access to it through the Medication-Assisted Treatment – Academic Community Capacity Expansion for Sustainable Success (SC MAT ACCESS) project.
