TOPIC	DISCUSSION	RECOMMENDATIONS/ACTION NEEDED
1. Resource Mapping	Discussed who in local communities has comprehensive information about existing community resources.	All will send "local keeper of resource information" names and contact info to Dr. Foster.
2. Work Group composition	Would be helpful if 301s and law enforcement attended participated in this work group	Debbie will invite representatives to participate in future meetings
3. Sobering Centers	Withdrawal and intoxication are main reasons for not excepting individuals into CSU's. There are no sobering centers in state yet, but Charleston Center will open one this summer.	Need sobering centers as they are inexpensive, efficient, and very effective as jail and ED diversion.
4. New Crisis Stabilization Regulations/licensure	DHEC, DHHS, SCDMH crafted new standards which were accepted by the DHEC Commission, and the House Health sub Committee.	Awaiting acceptance by general assembly. May not have time to pass this session.
5. LE/MH Intercept mapping	What "intercept" programs are taking place across the state and are they effective?	Debbie to send out the intercept map. (attached)
6. DMH seeking VOCA Grant	Grant will allow SCDMH to embed clinicians in 25 Law Enforcement agencies across the state. Also discussing embedding SCDMH MHPs in some SCDPPPS offices.	Awaiting award announcement
7. Telehealth	How can Telehealth expand crisis stabilization services and efforts?	SCDHHS to consider allowing non-medical staff to bill for telehealth services.
8. Children's needs	Communities report increased need for child inpatient beds.	Debbie will check on W.S. Hall census.
9. MCO Involvement	Increase MCO involvement in this work group's discussions.	Debbie to encourage same.
