TOPIC	DISCUSSION	RECOMMENDATIONS/ACTION NEEDED
1. Transporting Patients	Horry County sheriff's office transporting patients to Darlington county.	Want to request a law be enforced related to transporting patients (drowning of clients). Someone should be traveling with transporters that are trained to aid mentally ill. Should be documented under strategy 2.
2. Support short –stay crisis stabilization services for individuals experiencing a behavioral health emergency.	CCRI should not be documented as a responsible party.	Under Crisis Stabilization strategy 1 for the 1 st action step, remove CCRI as a responsible party and add them under crisis stabilization strategy 2 step 2.
3. Increase/coordinate mobile crisis units that respond to behavioral health crisis (rural areas)	CCRI'S Roll out time (Timeline).	Under Crisis Stabilization strategy 2, action step 2, the timeline of 3-5 years is a graceful time period. Would like to see 2 years for roll out. 3-5 years will give enough time for telehealth component.
